ABOUT OTA

OTA (Oyebog Tennis Academy) is a non-profit organization founded by Joseph Oyebog in 1999. Joseph, a native of Cameroon, is a former ATP pro, Davis Cup player and a Cameroon National Champion.

OTA was established to give underprivileged children an opportunity to not only gain tennis skills, but also to learn life skills (teamwork, self-confidence, etc)

There are over 25 centers functioning in Cameroon. The centers run totally on private donations. Most equipment i.e. new and used tennis rackets, shoes and balls is donated and shipped from the U.S.

Children at the centers are also given a free meal, where possible, and the use of donated equipment.

Over 10,000 children have been positively impacted through OTA including 20 players receiving college scholarships or coaching positions in the U.S. and Europe.

In 2012, a single donation was made to purchase a 16-acre plot of land less than 25 miles outside the capital of Douala, Cameroon. It was acquired with the purpose of creating an oasis for the children of OTA, a place that they could call their own. In the past few years we have built a facility that currently houses 16 of OTA's most deserving kids. They are fed and receive tennis training on campus and bused to local schools to continue their formal education. The vision for the future is that more than 250 children can live, train and be educated on site at the Souza Academy, giving them incredible access to opportunities previously beyond their reach. To realize this vision we will be working hard to raise the funds needed to continue construction and keep moving plans forward. The facilities currently include 4 clay tennis courts, a dormitory for 8 boys and 8 girls, bathrooms and showers, a water tower, a pineapple plantation, and primative kitchen.

Tennis opens the door to hope, higher education and unlimited opportunity.

This is run by the Oyebog Tennis Academy's US Board of Directors and is our biggest annual fundraiser.

Event Includes:

- Watching top ranked men and women tennis pros compete in exhibition matches.
- Dinner catered by A&S Fine Foods Westport
- Open Wine and Beer Bar by Liquid Assets
- View short film (5 minutes) made by professional videographers who travelled to Cameroon to capture the program, and learn about the children it supports and life there.
- All ages are welcome but there are no specific activities geared to smaller children. School age children have been very interested to see first-hand how some children in Africa live.
- Anyone who likes tennis will enjoy the caliber of the play in the exhibition matches.
- There were over 140 attendees in 2016 and over 160 in 2017.
 Attendees were predominantly adults but there were a good number of high school and junior high school students. Many of these were avid tennis fans but there were some who just wanted to support children and enjoy an evening out.
- 2016 and 2017 proceeds were used to support the ongoing program and to build two more tennis courts and a dormitory for 16 students at our campus in Souza, Cameroon, Africa as well as launch our new education initiative, Tennis Étude.
- 2018 proceeds will continue to support program needs and benefit OTA's new education initiative, Tennis Étude. This provides additional educational opportunities for children with the potential to get tennis scholarships to U.S. universities.
