WHY

OTA and its founder Joseph Oyebog have an enduring connection to the Fairfield County tennis community. Through his work teaching thousands of children over the past 20+ years here, Joseph has brought the benefits of tennis to underpriviliged children in his native Cameroon, Africa.

Students participating in "Serving for Love" will have the opportunity to strengthen this connection and make an enduring impact in Cameroon by raising funds to support OTAs mission to "improve the lives of children through the sport of tennis and its values of teamwork, determination, perseverance, kindness and generosity" - while gaining personal community service experience in a fun and meaningful way.

WHAT

Over seven weeks (starting April 3rd,2023), participants will recruit a team of their peers. Under the guidance of one of OTA's local board members, each team will develop and execute an action plan to reach its fundraising goal. The winning team (who raises the most money) will be honored at a grand finale celebration and receive a \$2500 Scholarship Grant, be profiled on OTA's website and featured in local media and Cameroon. Additional awards and recognition will also be given to teams and individuals in the following categories: 'Most Creative Campaign' and 'Best use of Social Media.'
